It is highly recommended that you maintain good mobile device and account security practices, as you will be liable for all usage on your account, regardless if somebody else used the services.

Some good security practices includes (Guide only – please search on-line for compressive mobile security practices)

- Not sharing your account password
- Not using easily guessable passwords
- Logging out of your account when finished and not leaving open on your PC when not in attendance.
- Placing a password keyboard lock onto your mobile device when it is not being used. Consult your device user manual or visit the device manufacture's website.
- Purchasing and installing remote locking and deletion software onto you mobile device in the vent you lose your device. – search on-line for various manufacturers.
- Calling your service provider as soon as possible to inform them of your lost active mobile device(s) and service account number(s) so that a bar can be placed on the accounts.
